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Identifying persons with multimorbidity who are most in need of proactive person-centred care in general practice

From a population of 17 million, GPs in the Netherlands now see nearly two million people with multimorbidity annually in their practices. These appear to be a very heterogeneous group, with large differences in their needs for care and support. In this seminar I will share some findings of studies we conducted in the Netherlands to gain a better understanding of the need for care and support of people with multimorbidity, and discuss their usefulness for designing integrated care programmes.
